RESOLUTION NO. 2024-25

**A RESOLUTION OF MEDIA BOROUGH, DELAWARE COUNTY, RATIFYING AND
REPORTING CONTRACTS MADE FOR THE PURPOSE OF EMERGENCY MAINTENANCE,
REPAIRS OR REPLACEMENTS TO SANITARY SEWER LATERAL SERVICE AT
BOROUGH BUILDING FACILITY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Pennsylvania Borough Code, at 8 P.S. § 1402 (d)(1.2), Borough Council is authorized to contract for emergency maintenance, repairs or replacements to sanitary sewer service lateral facility without advertised bids for the mitigation of a real or potential emergency involving a clear and present danger to the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the borough; and

WHEREAS, on January 18, 2024 the sanitary sewer service lateral of the Borough facilities required emergency maintenance, repairs or replacements; and

WHEREAS, Media Borough determined that the public health, safety and welfare would be served by immediately securing contractors and/or supplies for the emergency maintenance, repairs or replacements to sanitary sewer facilities without advertised bids, and the Borough Council now desires to ratify such determination.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Media Borough Council, Delaware County, Pennsylvania, hereby resolves as follows:


The Borough Council hereby ratifies and records the contracts secured by the Borough for emergency maintenance, repairs or replacements to the Borough Building – Sanitary Sewer Service Lateral infrastructure on January 18, 2024:

1. The emergency that necessitated the procurement of said contract was failure of sanitary sewer service lateral from the Borough Building to the connection to the main on Fourth Street.
- 2.. The Borough procured the emergency maintenance, repairs or replacements by the following process by authorizing the Borough Engineer to solicit availability via telephone and electronic scope and pricing, and upon obtaining a quote for the work at a price not to exceed \$57,000, to enter into a contract with such contractor as is first available to do the work for an amount not to exceed \$57,000.
4. The emergency maintenance, repairs or replacements do not constitute new additions, extensions or enlargements of existing facilities and equipment.
