



What to Recycle in Media Borough



Always

Put it all in the green bin
—"Single Stream"



Always

Rinse all containers



Glass

Bottles, jars, & containers
—broken is OK.



Plastics

Rigid containers with triangle
1, 2 and 5 only — But NOT
Styrofoam and plastic bags



Metals

Bimetallic and aluminum
cans; metal lids; caps, foil
containers



Paper

Newspaper, magazines, catalogs,
mail, paperback books, bags,
office paper, file folders



Cardboard

Corrugated & non-corrugated,
including food cartons

Other

Shredded office paper may be composted
Aseptic Packaging/Tetrapak: Rinsed juice,
broth boxes, etc.



Never

NO plastic bag liners for the
bins



Never

Nothing with food waste or body fluids
(greasy pizza boxes, diapers, pads)



Glass

Ceramics, chinaware, dishware,
glassware, window glass, mirrors, light
bulbs



Plastics

Plastic bags, Styrofoam, food wrap, or
any plastic without a triangle



Metals

Scrap metal, hangers, cooking pots &
pans, syringes/needles, appliances,
oil and paint cans



Paper

Soiled paper towels or tissue paper,
sheets of stickers or address labels,
waxed paper



Cardboard

Cardboard lined with plastic (i.e.
bubblewrap boxes), waxed/waterproof
cardboard

Other

E-Waste Hazardous Waste Food, liquids,
organic material Textiles and fabric cannot
be included in curbside recycling
