**RESOLUTION No. 2025-33**

**A Resolution Amending the Temporary Speedbump Pilot Program**

**WHEREAS**, Borough Council of Media at its October 17, 2024 legislative meeting adopted a Temporary Speedbump Pilot Program to provide guidance and establish requirements for the installation of temporary speedbumps on residential streets; and

**WHEREAS**, Borough Council seeks to further refine the criteria for installation to address specific safety concerns on streets of narrow width and locations with repetitive vehicular damage;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Borough of Media Temporary Speedbump Pilot Program is hereby amended as follows:

**1. Additional Requirements for Eligibility**

- Streets determined by Public Works to have a cartway width of less than fourteen (14) feet may be considered for speedbump installation regardless of the percentage of speeding data, provided that other eligibility requirements are met.
- Streets or blocks with documented incidents of repetitive vehicular damage may be considered for speedbump installation regardless of whether there is a documented police accident report.

**2. Implementation**

- All other provisions of the Temporary Speedbump Pilot Program shall remain in full force and effect.

**3. Appeal**

- Under exigent circumstances, if a residential street does not meet the requirements for participation, applicants may request a review from the Borough Engineer to allow an exemption into the program.
