MEDIA RECYCLES

ALL RECYCLABLES GO IN THE BIN.
IT'S SINGLE STREAM!

SCHEDULE

- Media Borough recycles once weekly.
- West of Jackson St. (including both sides of Jackson St.) on **Tuesday**.
- East of Jackson St. on **Thursday**.

RECYCLING TIPS

- All recyclables go in the bright green recycling container (32-gallon container is available for pick up at Borough Hall, 2nd Floor)
- 48 - gallon containers will be available September 2021
- Please rinse and clean all containers before recycling
- **Please no plastic bags or liners**

FOOD COMPOSTING: WHAT TO PUT IN THE YELLOW BUCKET

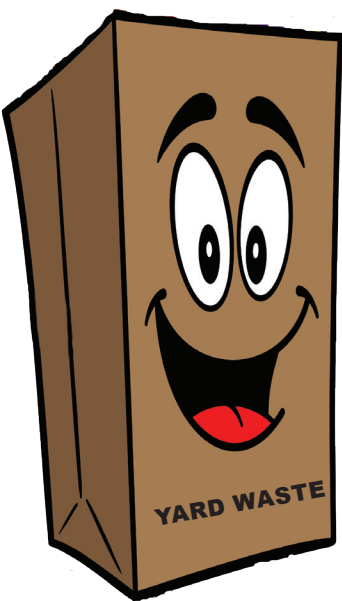

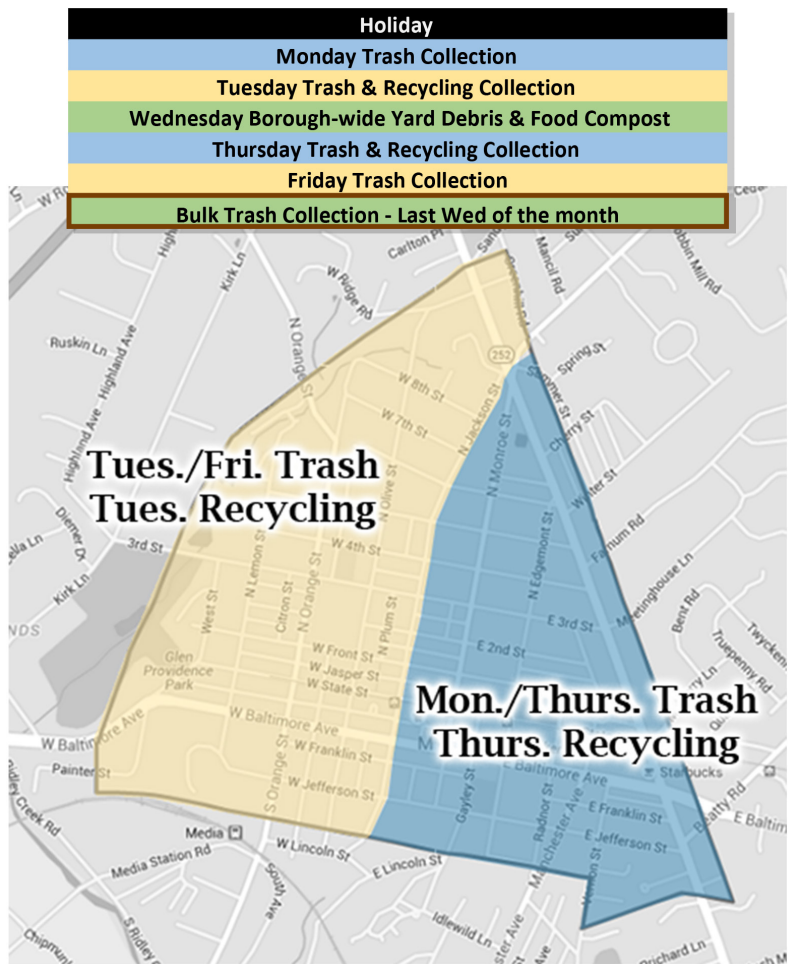
NEVER!

Please no plastic bags or plastic liners in the bucket
To help our sanitation crew, please line your bucket with a paper bag and rinse after collection day

YARD WASTE: WHAT TO PUT IN THE BROWN BAG



- Curbside collection items must be placed in recycled paper yard waste bags.
- Please do not over fill yard bags or make them heavier than what you can carry to the curb.
- Please do not use plastic trash bags for yard waste.
- Sticks/branches are accepted provided they are no wider than four (4) inches in diameter and no longer than four (4) feet. Sticks/branches larger than 2" in diameter cannot be placed inside the bags and must be bundled separately.
- Please do not put your yard waste curbside before Tuesday evening and no later than Wednesday at 6am for pickup on Wednesday.



TRASH PICK UP

2024 SCHEDULE

- Trash is collected twice weekly
- East of Jackson St. is collected on **Monday and Thursday**
- West of Jackson St. (including both sides of Jackson St.) on **Tuesday and Friday**
- If your scheduled trash collection day falls on a holiday, your trash will be picked up on the next regularly scheduled trash collection day

TRASH TIPS

- Each residence is permitted 3 - 32 gallon containers.
- Please do not place electronics in the trash. PA no longer allows computers, monitors, peripherals or TVs in land fills and incinerators. Local E-Waste events are posted on the Media Borough website.
- Bulk Trash is collected the last Wednesday of the month. Pickups must be scheduled by calling the Borough Hall by noon the Monday before pickup.
